

What we want to achieve

Our mission is to improve the well-being of people with a learning disability in Wales. We will do this by expanding, diversifying and ensuring greater access to a wide range of daytime opportunities, services and activities.

How we will do this

1. Improve access, quality and choice

Improve people's access to and choice of high-quality daytime opportunities, services and activities.

2. Enhance collaboration

Develop strong partnerships among organisations to share best practices, resources and joint working.

3. Increase agency

Stand up for the rights of people with a learning disability to have choice and control over the daytime opportunities, services and activities they take part in.

We believe:

- Everybody with a learning disability who has a need for support has the right to access appropriate daytime opportunities, services and activities.
- Everybody with a learning disability who takes part in daytime opportunities, services and activities has a right to choice and control about their participation.
- People's needs, wishes and ambitions change throughout their lives.
 People with a learning disability must be given opportunities to progress and change the support they access when it is right for them.

Values

This network is based on these values:

1. Collaboration

We value collaboration and partnership, recognising that together we can achieve more.

2. Innovation

We embrace innovation and new ways of working in providing daytime opportunities, services and activities.

3. Inclusion

The network will be an inclusive environment where contributors are treated with dignity and respect.

4. Empowerment

We are committed to empowering people with a learning disability to achieve their full potential.

Network membership

To be a member of the network, you must work for or represent an organisation that:

1. Provides daytime opportunities, services or activities for people with a learning disability in Wales.

and

2. Is third sector, not for profit, charity or community interest company (CIC).

and

3. Is a member of Learning Disability Wales or is applying to become a member.
