



Every political party publishes a manifesto a few weeks before elections.

A manifesto is a special political report.



A manifesto explains what sort of things are important to the party. This could be Health, Education, Transport, or something else.



It says what they promise to do if they are elected.

Manifestos can help us decide which political party to vote for.



Political parties will usually publish Easy Read manifestos to help voters understand what they promise they will do if they win.




Some parties also produce manifestos in braille, large print and BSL. Contact each party to ask for copies.


