# Is Shared Living the only way and not for people with complex needs?

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# Torfaen's Journey....

- In 2013 we started to consider a "different" housing option for people with learning disabilities
- In partnership with colleagues from Social Care Learning Disabilities team the journey began
  - LD team had aspirations for the people they worked with to live full independent lives
  - Working together to gather evidence to support the housing need
    - People currently living in support accommodation
    - People living with parent/family
    - People in residential educational establishments
    - Young people approaching transition into adulthood
    - Current costs of housing
  - Once we had the robust evidence we started to work with the people themselves
    - LD team did workshop, spoke with families, started preparing people to live independently



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# Continuing the Journey....

- Agreeing what the housing would look like
- Gaining Corporate approval (covering void periods/care/support packagers)
- Engaging with Housing Associations
- Identifying sites
- Securing capital funding
- Safeguarding/sustainability of the housing (all allocations of social care scheme are done through an allocations panel consisting of social care officers/housing association)



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#### Torfaen's 1<sup>st</sup> Scheme....

- Ty Cae Nant
- Site was a former primary school
- Land was sold by TCBC
- Local Contractor secured the site
- Worked with Melin Homes to deliver the scheme
- Opportunity to shape the development

- 111 unit mixed tenure scheme was approved by planning
  - 40 x market units
  - 21 x affordable units (socially rented/intermediate)
  - -41 x bed extra care (independent living for over 55's)
  - 9 x 1 bed flats for people with LD
  - Central Cwmbran

- Working closely with the LD team and Melin Homes independent living team work began on developing an offer pack.
- The LD team sent out a register of interest letter to everyone who had initially declared an interest in living independently.
- The LD team met individually with every individual who expressed an interest.
- Together with Melin Homes a shortlist was drawn up and offers made.
- All of this work was done in parallel with the development of the site
- A support package was tendered for 24 hour on site support
- All successful tenants and the support provider were then involved in the process going forward
  - Site visits, input into deco, flooring and tiling
  - £3.4m SHG












- To ensure the tenants understood their responsibilities and the Housing Associations responsibilities an easy read tenancy document was created.

#### Somerton House....


- We then moved onto developing a scheme for people with more complex needs.
- This scheme we worked with TCBC Learning Disabilities team along with the Adults Physical Disabilities team.
- The scheme delivered 16 x 1 bed flats with 24 hr onsite support
  - 4 x 1 bed flats for people with autism this unit has its own access and has a communal area with staff provision
  - 8 x 1 bed flats for people with physical disabilities (fully accessible)
  - 4 x 1 bed flats for people with learning disabilities
  - Achieving RNIB platinum accreditation
  - £1.6m SHG
  - Learning from Ty Cae Nat a marketing brochure was developed to assist with allocating the properties

#### Kennard Court....

- 6 Bungalows (4 x 1 bed, 2 x 2 bed)
- Blaenavon former retirement home scheme
- Bron Afon Community Housing
- 24hr care and support
- Allocated to people with PMLD
- £500k ICF
- Allocated through an allocations panel including ABUHB and Bron Afon

# Coed Cae Bungalows....

- 3 Fully accessible bungalows
- Assistive technology
- £377k ICF
- Bron Afon Community Housing
- Allocated to people with complex care/acquired brain injuries and Learning Disabilities
- Individual care packages commissioned by ABUHB
- Mr S has been in a hospital setting for over 10 years following a stroke but now has a home of his own



Mr S said: "The move back to Cwmbran has been strangely surreal. It's been a combination of wanting it for so long and it being very familiar, yet little things are different.

"All of my friends and family are so glad that I am in Cwmbran. Although it was very nice in Llanhennock, it was a little out of the way. I am already seeing the benefit, with people just popping in!"



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# Ysgol Panteg....

- In partnership with Social Care and ABUHB and In One Place
- First housing scheme to be delivered collaboratively with health and social care
- Jointly tendered care/support package
- Innovative approach take on design
- Flexibility to increase/decrease care/support as required



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
# Ysgol Panteg....


- 9 Units in total

- Allocated by a joint allocations panel TCBC/ABUHB/Melin Homes


