#### • **Procurement is a chosen option** Collaboration, Grant Funding, Simple Agreement, Concession, Make

• There are further choices to make Scope, Character, Quantity, Frequency, Relationship Basis, Terms

• **Co-Pro is about right fitting those choices** Tactical and Strategic choices; OPDCA (Observe Plan Do Check Act).

#### Pre-procurement

Market development, research, provider engagement, contract development.

#### • Process

Running an open, fair and transparent process; a series of events that distinguishes the commercial aspects and allows selection.

#### Execution

Delivering the goods or services, contract monitoring, delivery on the desired outcomes.



## **Relationship Basis**

## • Long –Term?

Common objectives, shared stake in good outcomes, less reliance on markets and competition.

### Sustainable

Loss of supplier and/or contract undesirable, essential infrastructures, preventative.

#### • Co-Destiny?

Little distinction between make/buy, complementary cultures, common risks/threats, mutual dependence, high incidence of co-working.



## **Rules**

#### Frameworks

Within frameworks the contract is formed when the order is placed.

#### • Contracts

Can be of any length. Contract length must be suited to application.

### • PCR 2015

Local Authorities own rules must apply.
