Information about the job



We have a job vacancy for a **Disabled People's Employment Champion**.



The pay you will get will be what a **Senior Executive Officer** gets.



It is to work for the **Welsh Government** in a team called the **Prosperous Futures Division, Education and Public Services Group**.



The job starts on April 1st 2020.



The job is for 1 year.

It will finish on 31st March 2021.



It is for 20 hours per week.



We are recruiting 3 people to work across different areas of Wales.

- North Wales
- Mid and South West Wales
- South East Wales



The people who get these jobs will work with other Champions.



The jobs will be to speak up for disabled people about employment.



They will be talking about the **social model of disability**. This says that the way society works can stop disabled people doing things other people do.



The people will talk to businesses across Wales to tell them about the skills disabled people have.



They will support businesses to recruit disabled people.



We are **only** recruiting disabled people for these jobs.

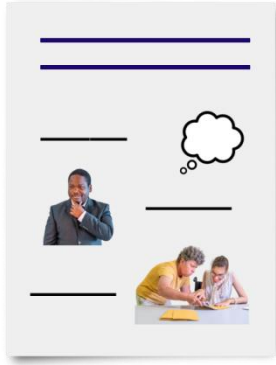
- why you would like to apply for the job

- tell us how your skills and experience meet the **job description**.



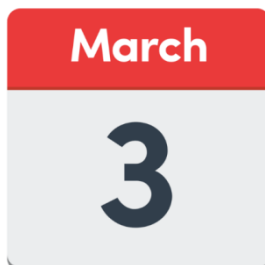
Please write this on up to 2 full sheets of paper on the **Expression of Interest** form.
