

How are things now?



The service is very varied across the Region – different names, different approaches Not all of the services are accessible or available for people with learning disabilities Not enough support to access groups or activities Physical or practical barriers – poor transport, lack of changing places

Steps towards making the service stronger

More joined-up working between the Connecter service and the LD services and community.

The service needs to be available to all, not based on labels. Improved and more accessible information and language. Needs to be much more than a 'signposting' service and there may need to be additional support to access groups or activities Other ideas and actions



Better central and more accessible information resources about community connecter services and groups.

Need to share more good examples featuring people with a learning disability.

Work on a community development approach More work on a 'presence to contribution' model Could people with a learning disability be working or volunteering in community connecter or buddy roles?
