

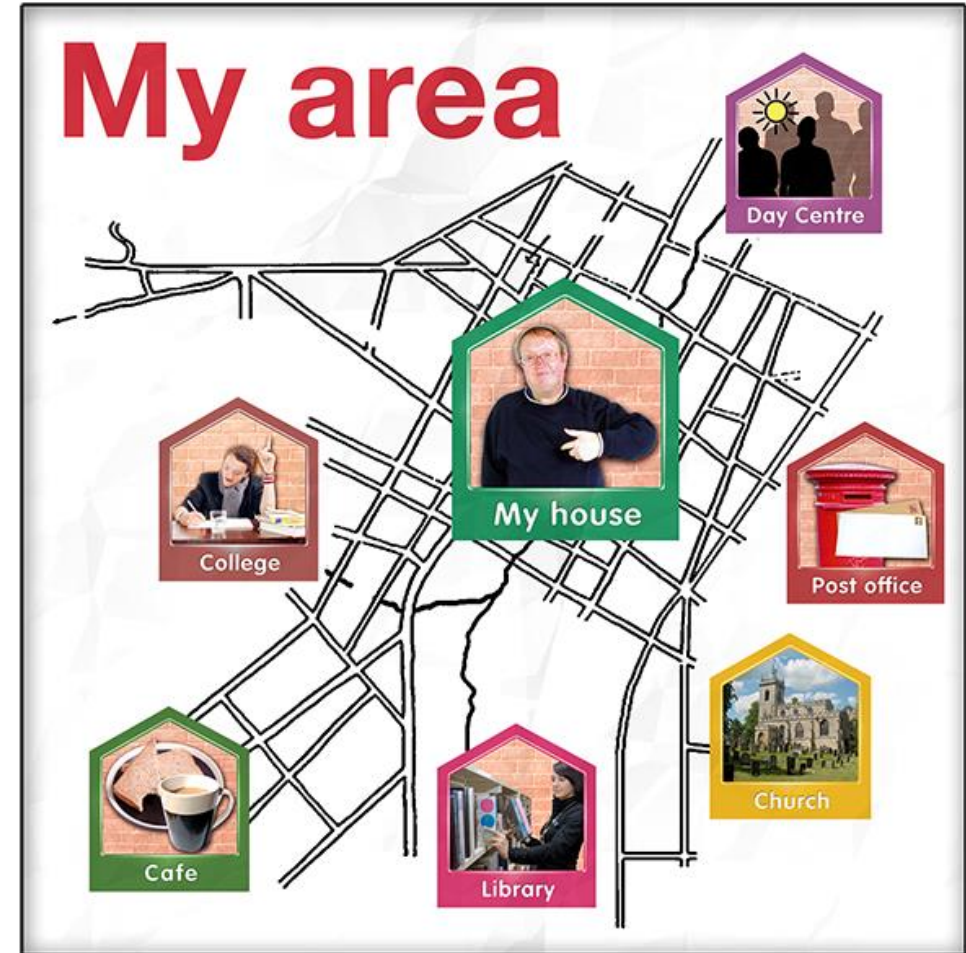

# An overview of what we found in May 2021

## How are things now?



**The service is very varied across the Region** – different names, different approaches

**Not all of the services are accessible or available for people with learning disabilities**

Not enough support to access groups or activities

Physical or practical barriers – poor transport, lack of changing places

## Steps towards making the service stronger



**More joined-up working** between the Connector service and the LD services and community.

**The service needs to be available to all**, not based on labels. Improved and more accessible information and language.

**Needs to be much more than a 'sign-posting' service** and there may need to be additional support to access groups or activities

## Other ideas and actions



**Better central and more accessible information resources** about community connector services and groups.

**Need to share more good examples** featuring people with a learning disability.

**Work on a community development approach**

More work on a 'presence to contribution' model

**Could people with a learning disability be working or volunteering in community connector or buddy roles?**
